Rules and Regulations

- Add/Change** Declarations must be made for hunter, equitation, jumper classes by 5pm or the day preceding the classes. Once the class has started it may not be scratched and will be charged for the class unless it is a veterinarian scratch. All scratches for classic's must be made 1 hour prior to the start of the class. **Same day add Fee \$5** unless otherwise stated.
- Non-Showing Horses** Must Pay a **\$70** non-showing fee.
- Camper Hookups** Limited number (25) for **\$290/week, \$480/series, \$370 SC/MN or MN/LC, \$130/MNC**. One hookup per camper All campers operating as a self-contained unit must park in van and truck parking area. No electric or water.
- No Golf Carts are to be charged/plugged into the electric in stabling area, also number of fans used will be limited.
- Splitting Tack Stalls/Feed/Bedding Orders.** The horse show office will be happy to split the tack stalls/feed/bedding per the Trainers instructions among customers up to each Friday at 11am, after that point the total account will be billed to the trainer's barn account
- Unlicensed Drivers** are not permitted to operate any motorized vehicles ATV's, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, etc. on the show grounds. See rule GR1301.7
- Bedding & Feed** must be ordered no later than **3pm** in show office. All bedding & feed must be ordered with stall order. Last delivery will be made at **5pm**.
- Returned Checks** A \$75 fee will be charged on returned checks. Accounts not settled within 2 weeks of show date will be reported to the USEF, per chapter 9, GR913.
- Dogs** Leashed at all times while on show grounds. Loose dogs will be picked up and detained until owner has paid \$100 fine. See **rule GR 1301.6**
- Parking** Vans, trailers, trucks, and cars parked in designated area. **Please Cooperate** with the organized parking out of consideration of others and keeping the show grounds accessible at all times. **Do not park in the stable/barn area, Fire and Cog ruling.**
- All Hunter Classic's with prize money require 6 entries or the classes may be combined or cancelled.
- Damages** Owners and Exhibitors shall be held responsible for damages on the show grounds and stalls incurred by them, their horses, agents, employees, etc. and will be billed same.
- Office Hours** 1 hour prior to show, until last class is finished.
- Headgear** All exhibitors are required to wear properly fitting protective headgear while mounted on the show grounds at all times. **GR801**
- Paddocks** are very limited on first come first serve basis. Only 21 available. **\$265/Week, \$345 SC/MN or MN/LC, \$430/series.** PADDOCKS MUST BE PREPAID. This will not be split between clients.
- Poling** Manuel poling of any horse or pony or the use of Bamboo/Metal/PVC is Prohibited. Horses in violation will be suspended from showing for a period of 24 hours from the time of the incident.
- Bio Hazardous** Medical waste must be placed in proper receptacles provided by show. Anyone found in violation of discarding on the ground or stall shall be subject to a fine of \$100.
- Jog for soundness** Horses/ponies are required to trot a circle on a loose rein at the end of each over fences performance. **Per HU118.3 Option A**
- Back Numbers Per HJ106.2** All Showing and non-showing horses must have their Back numbers on while mounted and handled.
- While every effort has been made to avoid mistakes in this publication. **State College Show Services LLC** and its management assume no liability for errors. Any significant errors will be disclosed to competitors upon their acceptance, and in accordance with USEF rules.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

Every horse will need to meet the new Vaccination requirements in accordance with the rule GR 845.0.

ENTIRES AND STALLS WILL BE LIMITED AS NECESSARY AND WILL BE TAKEN ON A PAID FIRST COME, FIRST SERVE BASIS.

Stalls may be LIMITED to 1 Tack/Groom Stall PER 4 HORSES ENTERED. **Stall Fees are NOT Refundable.** Checks must be forwarded to cover all stalls orders; **Priority** will be given to **SERIES** stall orders.

WEEKLY STALLS will not be available before **MONDAY** of the first week and **SUNDAY after 6pm for the Second week.** First week please try to **Vacate (ASAP)** at the conclusion of their showing on **Sunday**, if not staying for Mt. Nittany or the Lion Country shows. If you are **Moving in on 6/30, or 7/2 your stalls will not be available until Late Afternoon 6pm.** If you will be arriving between **Horse Shows** please plan ahead and contact the horse show to make sure your stalls will be ready, as stabling may be Limited. **Stalls Are 10x10 Temporary and clay limestone flooring.**

SCHOOLING Hacking/Flatwork only in the mornings until **6:45 to 7:15 depending on ring, Check Schooling Schedule.** All schooling in rings will be in one direction, all must switch directions please help keep it safe. **Schooling over jumps will be allowed but limited, at the conclusion of day if Time/Weather permits. No one is allowed in the rings after dusk.**

The Horse Show Management reserves the right to itself to refuse, accept conditionally, or to cancel any entries, disqualify any riders or exhibitors, prohibit exhibition of entries and cancel award prizes, without claim for damages, to change any course, to cancel combine any unfilled classes, or to reschedule classes after due notice to exhibitors, to change rings or rotate jumps to change specifications in jumper classes as competition warrants. Every horse entered for competition will be under the control of the horse Show Management, but the Show Management will in no case be responsible for any loss or damage that may occur, and it shall be a condition of the entry that each exhibitor shall hold this horse show, their directors, employees, and the officials and employees of the show blameless for any loss or accident to their horse(s), employee(s), or equipment which occur from sickness, fire, act of nature, or otherwise.

1. **Entries close JUNE 12, 2024.** A \$35 fee per horse late entry. No Stalls will be Reserved without enclosed check, limited to number of stalls.

2. **Stall Reservations** Stalls will only be reserved if the request is accompanied by a separate check filled out and signed for the full amount of money due for the stalls. Temporary stalls 10x10 with doors for the STATE COLLEGE CLASSIC, MT. NITTANY, AND LION COUNTRY, HORSE SHOWS are **\$455** for the entire series,

\$330 for the combination of STATE COLLEGE & MT. NITTANY, OR MT. NITTANY & LION COUNTRY. **\$265** for STATE COLLEGE CLASSIC and LION COUNTRY, **\$130** for MT. NITTANY.

3. **Entry form** to speed processing, fill out entry forms completely and accurately. Have all measurement cards, membership cards, and Vaccination records ready to be seen in the horse show office. All recording numbers, id numbers, membership numbers must be submitted with the entry form in order to make computerization of show results more efficient. **NUMBERS** will not be issued without having a **Signed open check** and all signatures and USEF/USHJA numbers complete. **Faxed entries will not be accepted.**

4. **Updates** Look for updates at www.horseshowing.com Also we will post in the office.

5. **Prize Money** will be awarded in the show office when the account is settled. Checks void after 30 days. Office must have 45 minutes after the conclusion of the class to have prize money credited to account.

USEF MEMBERSHIP STATEMENT

Life, senior active and junior active members shall be eligible to participate in all classes at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions at the Modified Level or above and Combined Driving Competitions at the Advanced Level, Dressage, Reining and Vaulting Competitions and Endurance Rides. A non-member may participate as a handler, rider, driver, owner, lessee, or agent, at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions, Dressage Competitions, Reining Competitions and Combined Driving Competitions upon payment of a Show Pass fee. Participants in the following classes are exempted from the requirements of this rule: 1) headline; 2) exhibitions; 3) games and races; 4) classes for 4-H members; 5) walk trot and academy classes (academy classes are classes limited to horses used regularly in a lesson program); 6) USDF introductory level tests, pas de deux and quadrille classes; 7) assistant handlers in Dressage Sport Horse Breeding classes.

FEDERATION ENTRY AGREEMENT

By entering a Federation-licensed Competition and signing this entry blank as the Owner, Lessee, Trainer, Manager, Agent, Coach, Driver, Rider, Handler, Vaultor or Longeur and on behalf of myself and my principals, representatives, employees and agents, I agree that I am subject to the Bylaws and Rules of The United States Equestrian Federation, Inc. (the "Federation") and the local rules of the State College Horse Show Series. I Agree to be bound by the Bylaws and Rules of the Federation and of the Competition. I will accept as final the decision of the Hearing Committee on any question arising under the Rules, and agree to release and hold harmless the competition, the Federation, their officials, directors and employees for any action taken under the rules.

I represent that I am eligible to enter and/or participate under the Rules, and every horse I am entering is eligible as entered.

I also agree that as a condition of and in consideration of acceptance of entry, the Federation and/or the Competition may use or assign photographs, videos, audios, cablecasts, broadcasts, internet, film, new media or other likenesses of me and my horse taken during the course of the competition for the promotion, coverage or benefit of the competition, sport, or the Federation. Those likenesses shall not be used to advertise a product and they may not be used in such a way as to jeopardize amateur status. I hereby expressly and irrevocably waive and release any rights in connection with such use, including any claim to compensation, invasion of privacy, right of publicity, or to misappropriation.

The construction and application of Federation rules are governed by the laws of the State of New York, and any action instituted against the Federation must be filed in New York State. See GR908.4.

MOTORIZED VEHICLE STATEMENT

Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind, including but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles, on the competition grounds of licensed competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above-described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. The parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating a motorized vehicle in violation of this rule are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses, or actions resulting from that operation. Violations of this rule will be cause for penalties against those responsible for the child committing the offense. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule. The unsafe use of personal electronic transport devices, as determined by the competition officials and management in their sole discretion, that do not require a driver's license to operate, including but not limited to segways, hover boards, and single wheeled scooters is prohibited on competition grounds. Operating such devices in areas where people gather may be deemed "unsafe use" if there is a risk of harm to others. If the operator of the device is a minor, the parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating the device in violation of this rule is accountable and may be subject to penalties. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.

SAFE SPORT STATEMENT

Effective immediately, any competition with the start date of September 1, 2020 and later will be required to include the following Safe Sport statement in the Rules and Regulation section of the prize list: Reminder: All USEF Life and Senior Active members, as well as participants who have regular contact with minor athletes, are required to comply with the U.S. Center for SafeSport training requirement to be eligible to participate in the competition. All Participants must adhere to the U.S. Center for SafeSport Code, USEF SafeSport Policy, and the Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policies. RULES GOVERNING THE AWARDS

1. To Be eligible for High Score Awards, all horses and ponies must be nominated and the person(s) in whose name(s) the horse or pony is showing, or the child who is showing in horsemanship classes, must be a current member of the Syracuse Chapter PHA. No points will count towards the High Score Awards until after the dates and nominations are received by the PHA Secretary.

2. THE SYRACUSE PHA MEDAL EQUITATION CLASSES

Unless noted otherwise, all classes to be shown over a course of not less than 6 obstacles, which may include one combination including an oxer and change of direction. Fences for Junior Hunter Riders 3'6" and/or 3'3", fences for Children's Hunter Horses and Adult Hunter Riders 3', fences for Children's Hunter Large Ponies 2'6" Small-Medium Ponies 2', Low-Children's Hunters and Low-Adult Hunters 2'6", Low Pony Hunter 2'. Medal class USEF Tests for Junior Hunter Riders 1-17, All others Tests 1-7. Testing is optional in all classes and/or the Judge may elect to include one or more tests in the original course. Every Member Show is required to offer a Junior, Children's and Adult PHA Medal Class if they offer the corresponding Hunter Divisions. Other Medals are optional. Management may offer a separate class for riders of Children's Hunter Ponies, Low-Children's Hunter, Low-Adult Hunter and/or Low Pony Hunter. Horses and Riders showing in the Junior Hunter Division, may not enter the Children's Medal at the same show. Children's Pony Riders may enter the USEF Pony Medal

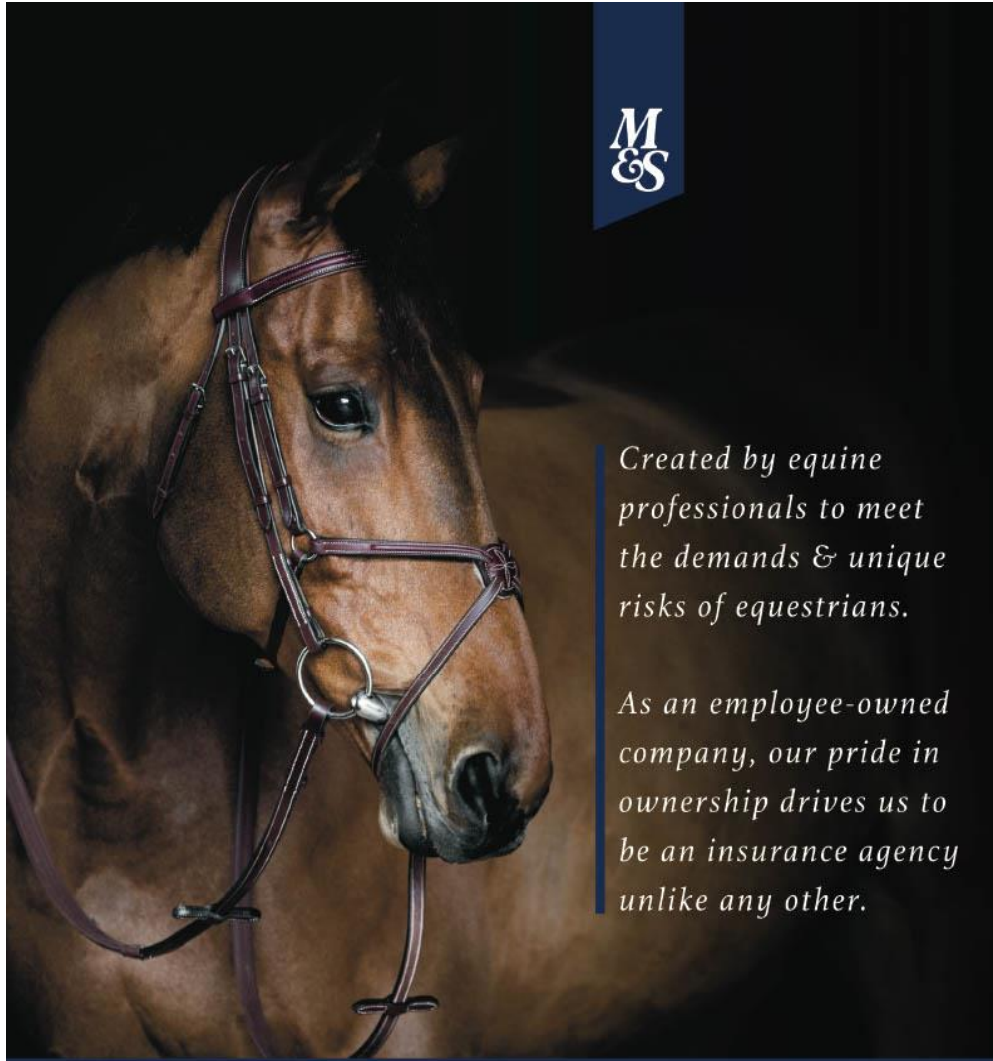

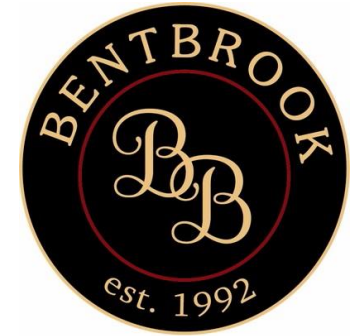

WAIVER AND RELEASE OF LIABILITY, ASSUMPTION OF RISK AND INDEMNITY AGREEMENT

For and in consideration of United States Equestrian Federation, Inc. dba US Equestrian ("USEF") allowing me, the undersigned, to participate in any capacity (including as a rider, driver, handler, vaulter, longeur, lessee, owner, agent, coach, official, trainer or volunteer) in a USEF sanctioned, licensed or approved event or activity, including but not limited to equestrian clinics, practices, shows, competitions and related or incidental activities and State College Horse Show Series ("USEF Event" or "USEF Events"); I, for myself, and on behalf of my spouse, children, heirs and next of kin, and any legal and personal representatives, executors, administrators, successors, and assigns, hereby agree to and make the following contractual representations pursuant to this Agreement (the "Agreement"):

A. RULES AND REGULATIONS: I hereby agree that I have read, understand, and agree to be bound by all applicable Federation Bylaws, rules, and policies including the USEF Safe Sport Policy and Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policies (MAAPP) as published at www.usef.org, as amended from time to time.

B. ACKNOWLEDGMENT OF RISK: I knowingly, willingly, and voluntarily acknowledge the inherent risks associated with the sport of equestrian and know that horseback riding and related equestrian activities are inherently dangerous, and that participation in any USEF Event involves risks and dangers including, without limitation, the potential for serious bodily injury (including broken bones, head or neck injuries), sickness and disease (including communicable diseases), trauma, pain & suffering, permanent disability, paralysis and death; loss of or damage to personal property (including my mount & equipment) arising out of the unpredictable behavior of horses; exposure to extreme conditions and circumstances; accident involving other participants, event staff, volunteers or spectators; contact or collision with other participants and horses, natural or manmade objects; adverse weather conditions; facilities issues and premises conditions; failure of protective equipment (including helmets); inadequate safety measures; participants of varying skill levels; situations beyond the immediate control of the USEF Event organizers and competition management; and other undefined, not readily foreseeable and presently unknown risks and dangers ("Risks").

EQUINE ACTIVITY LIABILITY ACT WARNING:

CAUTION: HORSEBACK RIDING AND EQUINE ACTIVITIES CAN BE DANGEROUS. RIDE AT YOUR OWN RISK.

Under the laws of most States, an equine activity sponsor or equine professional is not liable for any injury to, or the death of, a participant in equine activities resulting from the inherent risks of equine activities.

C. ASSUMPTION OF RISK: I understand that the aforementioned Risks may be caused in whole or in part or result directly or indirectly from the negligence of my own actions or inactions, the actions or inactions of others participating in the USEF Events, or the negligent acts or omissions of the Released Parties defined below, and I hereby voluntarily and knowingly assume all such Risks and responsibility for any damages, liabilities, losses, or expenses that I incur as a result of my participation in any USEF Events. I also agree to be responsible for any injury or damage caused by me, my horse, my employees or contractors under my direction and control at any USEF Event.

D. WAIVER AND RELEASE OF LIABILITY, HOLD HARMLESS AND INDEMNITY: In conjunction with my participation in any USEF Event, I hereby release, waive and covenant not to sue, and further agree to indemnify, defend and hold harmless the following parties: USEF, USEF Recognized Affiliate Associations, the United States Olympic & Paralympic Committee (USOPC), USEF clubs, members, Event participants (including athletes/riders, coaches, trainers, judges/es/officials, and other personnel), the Event owner, licensee, and competition managers; the promoters, sponsors, or advertisers of any USEF Event; any charity or other beneficiary which may benefit from the USEF Event; the owners, managers, or lessors of any facilities or premises where a USEF Event may be held; and all directors, officers, employees, agents, contractors, and volunteers of any of the aforementioned parties (**Individually and Collectively, the "Released Parties" or "Event Organizers"**), with respect to any liability, claim(s), demand(s), cause(s) of action, damage(s), loss, or expense (including court costs and reasonable attorney fees) of any kind or nature ("Liability") which may arise out of, result from, or relate in any way to my participation in the USEF Events, including claims for Liability caused in whole or in part by the negligent acts or omissions of the Released Parties.

E. COMPLETE AGREEMENT AND SEVERABILITY CLAUSE: This Agreement represents the complete understanding between the parties regarding these issues and no oral representations, statements or inducements have been made apart from this Agreement.
