RULES GOVERNING THE AWARDS

To be eligible for High Score Awards, all horses and ponies must be nominated and the person(s) in whose name(s) the horse or pony is showing, or the child who is showing in horsemanship classes, must be a current member of the Syracuse Chapter PHA. No points will count towards the High Score Awards until after the dues and nominations are received by the PHA Secretary. SYRACUSE PHA MEDAL EQUITATION CLASSES Unless noted otherwise, all classes to be shown over a course of not less than 6 obstacles, which may include one combination including an oxer and one change of direction. Fences for Junior Hunter Riders 3'6" &/or 3'3"; fences for Children's Hunters Horses and Adult Riders 3'; fences for Children's Hunters Large Ponies 2'6", Small-Medium Ponies 2', Low-Child & Low-Adult Horses 2'6", Low-Child Ponies 2'. Medal Class USEF Tests for Jr Hunter Riders 1-22; All others . Testing is optional in all classes and/or the Judge may elect to include one or more tests in the original course. Every Member show is required to offer a Jr, Children's & Adult PHA Medal Class if they offer the corresponding Hunter Divisions. Other medals are optional. Management may offer a separate class for riders of Children's Hunter Ponies and/or Pre-Children's Ponies. Horses and riders showing in the Junior Hunter Division, may not enter the Children's Medal at the same show. Children's Pony riders may enter the USEF Pony Medal Additional rules explained in the current Syracuse PHA Rule Book.

GREEN HUNTERS - Use USEF Rule HU131

Syracuse PHA will follow the USEF rules for the Green Hunters 3' & 3'3" sections.

LOW ADULT & LOW CHILDREN'S HUNTERS will follow the the USHJA Zone 2 Specifications.



SCHOOLING

The Arena will be open for schooling over a full course of fences on Tuesday, April 25th 8am-2pm & Wednesday, April 26th 4:00 AM-7:00 AM (These days not licensed by USEF) The Arena is available for riding every evening after the show until 11:30pm and every morning from 4 AM until 60 minutes prior to the start of the show.

There will be jumps left in the ring each evening and schooling sessions may be controlled.

Footing in the showring and warm-up area is a mixed sand. The show ring is approximately $118' \times 220'$, The covered warm-up area is approximately $85' \times 180'$ with same footing.

Per HJ106.2. All entered horses in the schooling area or warm-up area must have its show number attached to the horse or the individual riding or handling. Any horse without its correct number will be asked to leave the area.

HEALTH REQUIRMENTS

PLEASE NOTE:

The following Health Requirements MUST be met by all horses.

Proof of Influenza and Herpes vaccines within six months per USEF GR844 must be presented for each horse.

Proof of a current Rabies Inoculation administered within 12 months of the current show dates and

HORSES STABLED IN NEW YORK STATE:

Must present a Negative Coggins Test certificate dated in 2023 or 2024. Please attach a legible copy to your entry blank (OR SEND VIA EMAIL).

Horses that were in Florida after April 12th will be required to present a current health certificate and have their temperatures logged for the 7 days prior to arrival.

Copies of ALL health papers must be filed with the show office prior to picking up numbers.

HORSES STABLED OUTSIDE NY STATE:

Must present a **Negative Coggins** Test certificate-dated SINCE 4/28/2023. Please attach a legible copy to your entry blank.

AND: a current Health Certificate-dated within 30 days of your arrival in NY State from your local veterinarian.

ADDS & SCRATCHES

Adds and scratches can be made online, in the horse show office or via text Please include your horse's name and back #, rider name and class #s. Adds and Scratches must be made by 5pm the day prior to class. Same Day Adds may be limited or not permitted.

NOTATIONS

No conformation in pony divisions. In Rated classes, please trot a circle on a loose rein for the jog. Incomplete entries will not be processed

AMATEUR

All exhibitors in Amateur Sections measurement amateur certification at the Show Office before numbers can be picked up.

ENTRIES

Entries close April 15th. POST ENTRIES ACCEPTED AT THE REGULAR FEES UNTIL 5:00 PM FOR THE FOLLOWING DAY'S CLASSES. **THERE WILL BE \$50.00 SURCHARGE FOR ALL NEW HORSES ENTERED ON THE SAME DAY THEY COMPETE**. CLASSES MAY BE ADDED TO ANY EXISTING ENTRY WITHOUT LATE FEES.

Management reserves the right to limit courtesy circles and to conduct any class in an alternate location.

Incomplete entries will not be processed

ENTRY BLANKS

Entry Blanks will not be accepted unless signed by both the owner or his authorized agent and the trainer and accompanied by a check for Entry Fees & Stabling. **Open checks are acceptable for entries but stall checks need to be complete.**

A surcharge of \$100.00 plus collection fees will be made for all nonnegotiable checks. Canadian checks must be marked: Payable in U.S. Funds. checks. Canadian checks must be marked: Payable in U.S. Funds . **Please make Checks payable to "Syracuse PHA"**

HORSE IDENTIFICATION

All Horses must have USHJA # on the entry form or apply for one at the show. **Per HU104** All horses competing in classes that require USHJA horse registration must provide a microchip number that verifies their animal's identity. Horses can be microchipped at the Horse Show.

BACK NUMBERS

A number will be assigned to each horse when the entry is made. This number must be displayed whenever the horse is shown. Non showing horses must be entered in the horse show office. individual riding or handling. Any horse without its correct number will be asked to leave the area. **Per HJ106.2** . All entered horses in the schooling area or warm-up area must have its show number attached to the horse or the rider/handler. Non Showing horses must be entered through the horse show office and all entry blanks and waivers must be signed.

MEMBERSHIP STATEMENT

Life, senior active and junior active members shall be eligible to participate in all classes at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions at the Modified Level or above and Combined Driving Competitions at the Advanced Level, Dressage, Reining and Vaulting Competitions and Endurance Rides. A non-member may participate as a handler, rider, driver, owner, lessee, or agent at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions, Dressage Competitions, Reining Competitions and Combined Driving Competitions upon payment of a Show Pass fee. Participants in the following classes are exempted from the Requirements of this rule: 1) leadline; 2) exhibitions; 3) games and races; 4) classes for 4-H members; 5) walk trot and academy classes (academy classes are classes limited to horses used regularly in a lesson program); 6) USDF introductory level tests, pas de deux and quadrille classes; 7) assistant handlers in Dressage Sport Horse Breeding classes

SAFE SPORT STATEMENT

SAFE SPORT STATEMENT: Effective immediately, any competition with the start date of September 1, 2020 and later will be required to include the following Safe Sport statement in the Rules and Regulation section of the prize list: Reminder: All USEF Life and Senior Active members, as well as participants who have regular contact with minor athletes, are required to comply with the U.S. Center for SafeSport training requirement to be eligible to participate in the competition. All participants must adhere to the U.S. Center for SafeSport Code, USEF Safe Sport Policy, and the Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policies. More information about these can be found at www.usef.org.

MOTORIZED VEHICLE STATEMENT

Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind, including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles, on the competition grounds of licensed competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. The parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating a motorized vehicle in violation of this rule are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses or actions resulting from that operation. Violations of this rule will be cause for penalties against those responsible for the child committing the offense. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule. The unsafe use of personal electronic transport devices, as determined by the competition officials and management in their sole discretion, that do not require a driver's license to operate, including but not limited to segways, hover boards, and single wheeled scooters is prohibited on competition grounds. Operating such devices in areas where people gather may be deemed "unsafe use" if there is a risk of harm to others. If the operator of the device is a minor, the parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating the device in violation of this rule is accountable and may be subject to penalties. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.

REFUNDS

All fees will be refunded if entries are canceled on or before April 15th. There will be a \$50.00 office charge for all scratches after April 15th. There will be NO refunds on stalls. Once the show has started, refunds or credits for ill or injured horses will require a veterinarian's certificate be filed in the show office prior to the class(es) in question. Exhibitors shall be held responsible for the entry fees of all horses entered by them or their agents even though payment of these fees is not submitted along with the Entry Blanks. When a horse is disqualified from showing by the Management or officials, the entry fee will not be refunded.

TACK AND ATTIRE

PER JP111.4 Draw Reins/German Martingales. Draw reins and German Martingales may only be used in a conventional manner when schooling or in classes with no prize money that are offered at 1.20m or below. Ponies may not be ridden by a Junior in draw reins or German martingales at any time. No other head set devices (chambon, etc.) are permitted in any class. Draw Reins and German Martingales are not permitted in age restricted classes.

CHILDREN'S HUNTER PONY

Rider may not cross enter into any other class at the same competition where the fences exceed 3'0" (exception: Children's Jumper, Pony Jumpers, USHJA National Hunter Derby and Equitation Classes where the fences do not exceed 3'6"). A rider on a Children's Hunter Pony may NOT cross enter into the Pony Hunter section or Green Pony Hunter section at the same competition. For and in consideration of United States Equestrian Federation, Inc. dba US Equestrian ("USEF") allowing me, the undersigned, to participate in any capacity (including as a rider, driver, handler, vaulter, longeur, lessee, owner, agent, coach, official, trainer or volunteer) in a USEF sanctioned, licensed or approved event or activity, including but not limited to equestrian clinics, practices, shows, competitions and related or incidental activities and Syracuse PHA Horse Show "USEF Events"); I, for myself, and on behalf of my spouse, children, heirs and next of kin, and any legal and personal representatives, executors, administrators, successors, and assigns, hereby agree to and make the following contractual representations pursuant to this Agreement (the "Agreement"):

A. RULES AND REGULATIONS: I hereby agree that I have read, understand, and agree to be bound by all applicable Federation Bylaws, rules, and policies including the USEF Safe Sport Policy and Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policies (MAAPP) as published at www.usef.org, as amended from time to time.

B.
