To be eligible for High Score Awards, all horses and ponies must be nominated and the person(s) in whose name(s) the horse or pony is showing, or the child who is showing in horsemanship classes, must be a current member of the Syracuse Chapter PHA. No points will count towards the High Score Awards until after the dues and nominations are received by the PHA Secretary.

**THE SYRACUSE PHA MEDAL EQUITATION CLASSES** Unless noted otherwise, all classes to be shown over a course of not less than 6 obstacles, which may include one combination including an oxer and one change of direction. Fences for Junior Hunter Riders 3'6" &/or 3'3"; fences for Children's Hunters Horses and Adult Riders 3'; fences for Children's Hunters Large Ponies 2'6", Small-Medium Ponies 2', Nqy -Child & Nqy -Adult Horses 2'6", Nqy Ponies 2'. Medal Class USEF Tests for Jr Hunter Riders 1-17; All others .ts Testing is optional in all classes and/or the Judge may elect to include one or more tests in the original course. Every Member show is required to offer a Jr, Children's & Adult PHA Medal Class if they offer the corresponding Hunter Divisions. Other medals are optional. Management may offer a separate class for riders of Children's Hunter Ponies and/or Low-Children's Ponies. Horses and riders showing in the Junior Hunter Division, may not enter the Children's Medal at the same show. Children's Pony riders may enter the USEF Pony Medal **Additional rules explained in the current Syracuse PHA Rule Book. GREEN HUNTERS - Use USEF Rule HU 106-3**

**All Hunter Classes** will be judged on performance and soundness unless otherwise noted. **In Hunter Under Saddle Classes** horses are shown at a walk, trot and canter both ways of the ring. Light contact with the horse's mouth required. Horses should be obedient, alert, responsive and move freely. They should not be eliminated for slight errors. Judges may ask horses to hand gallop collectively, one way of the ring in Regular, Junior, Amateur-Owner & Pony Hunter Classes. No more than eight entries may be asked to hand gallop at one time. To be eligible for Under Saddle Classes in any B rated divisions animals must be entered in at least one over fences class in the same division.

## GENERAL INFORMATION

- Every class offered herein which is covered by the rules and specifications of the current USEF Rule Book will be conducted and judged in accordance therewith.
- STABLING: Limited Stabling Is Available at Lehman Farms. Stall Fees: \$90.00 for the weekend for permanent box stalls (10'x12') with doors with dirt floors. FOR STALL RESERVATIONS: Contact Gail Miller 585-721-9415. Straw Bedding Included
- No person shall be allowed to ride in an Amateur Class who does not have a current USEF amateur certification or complete the appropriate paper work to apply for one in the show office. All Pony, Junior, Children's Pony Hunters & Low Ponies must show current measurement cards or be measured at the show.
- The management reserves the right to change the order of classes before or during the show and to combine or cancel classes or divisions with fewer than four entries.
- All prize money will be paid in the show office or credited to the exhibitor's bill.
- There will be a \$100.00 surcharge added to all checks returned by the bank. A billing charge of \$50.00 will be added to all accounts not settled in full at the show. The indoor show ring is approximately 80' X 225'. Indoor Schooling 66' X 199'. Both have sand footing.
- Lehman Farms and the show manager take no responsibility for loss, injury or damage to horses, exhibitors, equipment and anyone connected there to.
- Each horse/rider is responsible for paying a \$35.00 EMT/Insurance Fee.
- Schooling will be available the afternoon prior to the first day of the show for horses entering the show. A \$45.00 schooling fee will be charged if no entry is made.
- Full payment or a signed check must be left with the secretary before numbers are issued.
- Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind, including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles, on the competition grounds of licensed competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. The parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating a motorized vehicle in violation of this rule are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses or actions resulting from that operation. Violations of this rule will be cause for penalties against those responsible for the child committing the offense. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule. The unsafe use of personal electronic transport devices, as determined by the competition officials and management in their sole discretion, that do not require a driver's license to operate, including but not limited to segways, hover boards, and single wheeled scooters is prohibited on competition grounds. Operating such devices in areas where people gather may be deemed "unsafe use" if there is a risk of harm to others. If the operator of the device is a minor, the parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating the device in violation of this rule is accountable and may be subject to penalties. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.
- Life, senior active and junior active members shall be eligible to participate in all classes at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions at the Modified Level or above and Combined Driving Competitions at the Advanced Level, Dressage, Reining and Vaulting Competitions and Endurance Rides. A non-member may participate as a handler, rider, driver, owner, lessee, or agent at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions, Dressage Competitions, Reining Competitions and Combined Driving Competitions upon payment of a Show Pass fee. Participants in the following classes are exempted from the Requirements of this rule: 1) leadline; 2) exhibitions; 3) games and races; 4) classes for 4-H members; 5) walk trot and academy classes (academy classes are classes limited to horses used regularly in a lesson program); 6) USDF introductory level tests, pas de deux and quadrille classes; 7) assistant handlers in Dressage Sport Horse Breeding classes
- \$4890 Prize Money is offered at each horse show. In 2023 LF January paid \$315, in prize money LF Feb paid \$300, LF Mar pid \$400 in prize money
- Per HJ106.2 . All entered horses in the schooling area or warm-up area must have its show number attached to the horse or the individual riding or handling. Any horse without its correct number will be asked to leave the area.

For and in consideration of United States Equestrian Federation, Inc. dba US Equestrian (“USEF”) allowing me, the undersigned, to participate in any capacity (including as a rider, driver, handler, vaulter, longeur, lessee, owner, agent, coach, official, trainer or volunteer) in a USEF sanctioned, licensed or approved event or activity, including but not limited to equestrian clinics, practices, shows, competitions and related or incidental activities and Lehman Farms horse Show (“USEF Event” or “USEF Events”); I, for myself, and on behalf of my spouse, children, heirs and next of kin, and any legal and personal representatives, executors, administrators, successors, and assigns, hereby agree to and make the following contractual representations pursuant to this Agreement (the “Agreement”):

A. RULES AND REGULATIONS: I hereby agree that I have read, understand, and agree to be bound by all applicable Federation Bylaws, rules, and policies including the USEF Safe Sport Policy and Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policies (MAAPP) as published at www.usef.org, as amended from time to time.

B.
