Equine Education Scholarship:

This scholarship is open to all members of the Syracuse Chapter PHA, who have shown an interest and good Sportsmanship in any aspect of the horse industry. A candidate may apply for this scholarship to help with any type of equine related activity, that will educationally benefit the candidate.

The amount of the scholarship will be up to \$500. More than one scholarship may be awarded during a calendar year. This award is to be used for riding, lessons with a professional of their choice, clinics, educational seminars, betterment of the rider or any other activity that the scholarship committee feels qualifies.

To qualify for the scholarship, the candidate must:

- Have been a member in good standing for at least three calendar years.
- Submit an application at a quarterly meeting, prior to the date of the Equine
 Education. A completed packet must be submitted to the scholarship committee.
- Write an essay, approximately 500 words, on "How has their equestrian experience impacted their life."
- Submit a resume if your equine experience, and what fund will be used for.
 Please indicate the amount requested, if necessary.
- Provide one letter of recommendation, showing how the candidate has demonstrated that they are an outstanding sportsman, and an asset to our horse community.
- Applicant must submit proof of bill and/or payment. This may include clinic fee and travel expense receipts.
